FLAVA WORKS SUES MARC JURIS FOR COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT

Continuing to take a aggressive legal stand against porn piracy

CHICAGO (AUGUST 16, 2017) – Flava Works has announced today that it has filed a lawsuit against Marc Juris for Copyright Infringement. Flava Works' alleges that Marc Juris is a active member of several illegal gay file sharing including Gay-Torrents.org.

The lawsuit was filed in Federal Court for the Northern District of Illinois, where Mr. Juris expressly agreed to jurisdiction when he signed up for Flava Works' websites and agreed to its' terms and conditions. The Case number is Case 1:17-cv-05957 and is assigned to the honorable Judge Amy J. St. Eve. A copy of the complaint is available at FlavaWorks.com/legal/

Flava Works sent Mr. Juris a Cease and Desist letter in early June and offered him an opportunity to settle this out of court – he declined and continued to access these illegal file sharing websites.

Flava Works plans to file a series of lawsuits against other alleged copyright infringers who are members of Gay-Torrents.org, GayTorrent.RU and several other illegal file sharing websites soon, to put an end to the rampant stealing of its' intellectual property.

"Flava Works models and staff spend countless hours producing our high quality videos and images only to have a few people steal them and distribute to these illegal file sharing websites. This will stop, one lawsuit at a time." said Flava Works' CEO Phillip Bleicher.
